

Checklist for safety orientation at CMM

All new arrivals need to be guided through a safety orientation by the research group leader, safety officer, or other staff with sufficient knowledge, before applying for CMM IT account, keys and key cards.

Emergency telephone numbers (CMM telephone list, 6000)
Evacuation plan, emergency exits, assembly point (show)
Evacuation leader kit (where to find it, how it works)
Fire extinguishers, fire blankets (where to find them)
Eye showers in lab, portable eye showers; emergency showers in corridor (how to operate)
First aid kit (where to find it)
Risk assessments for lab work (where to find them; mandatory to read before working in lab)
Safety data sheets (where to find them)
Correct PPE (gloves, goggles, lab coat etc.) must be used (inform)
No gloves or lab coats in kitchen areas, no gloves outside lab areas (inform)
Chemical spill kit, vermiculite (where to find it)
Chemical storage (chemical room, cabinets, always return flammable bottles to fire safe cabinet)
Chemical/infectious waste handling, recycling routines (inform)
Occupational health (contact information, services)
Safety officer, Work environment group (contact information)
Defibrillator by the CMM main entrance (show where)
